**Subject: 100% sale of liquor through scanning and completing MSR activity.**

Sir/Madam,

It has come to notice of this Department that after re-opening of some L-6 & L-8 liquor vends from 04<sup>th</sup> May 2020, some of these vends are not observing directions issued by the Excise Department regarding "no liquor sale should be done without proper scanning of each bottle". According to the data being received in ESCIMS, only 10-15% of liquor sold at vends is being scanned before selling. This practice, besides blatant violation of orders of the Excise Department, is also likely to lead to submission of inaccurate daily sales information sought by Hon'ble Dy. Chief Minister/Finance Minister, Delhi after imposition of 70% Special Corona Fee on the MRP of each bottle and also creation of MSR Gap.

It is hereby directed that MSR activity at all vends opened post lockdown i.e 04/05/2020 shall be carried out by 20/05/2020. Further, any other vend which will be allowed to open in future will first complete MSR activity and subsequently resume retail sale activity at the vend.

Furthermore, complaints of over-charging from the customers are also being received at various levels.



It is requested that the above said issues may kindly be taken-up seriously and strict directions must be issued to the vend-in-charges as regard to 100% sale through scanning and other directions issued by the Department from time to time.
